



Spay/Neuter Policy

Roverwood requires that all dogs participating in day play be spayed or neutered over the age of six months or when the dog starts showing signs of maturity (humping, marking, female cycle, etc.). It is our experience that dogs who are not altered may not have the best experience in a group environment. Dogs who are not altered may be subject to unwanted attention, varying anywhere from non-acceptance to humping or full-blown aggression from otherwise social dogs. The chemistry and energy of the play group increases dramatically, not in a good way, when introducing an unaltered adult dog. Usually this has very little to do with the unaltered dogs' personality or temperament, but the other dogs in the group.

Dogs who are not spayed or neutered can still board with us at **Roverwood**. Individual walks or alone time or time with the family dogs, if applicable, in the play yards will be provided and may be subject to an additional charge of \$10/night.
